## Notes Pertaining to all Continuing Education Registers

- All programs that employ non-grid teachers must be recorded on Continuing Education registers.
- All teachers/instructors must be directly employed by the board.
- All registers should be generated upon program completion and then saved, e.g., electronic copy or printed copy.
- Principal sign off is required on attendance registers
- By 2017-2018, all funding data submissions will be electronic.

## Enrolment and Attendance on Con Ed Registers

Funding starts the first session the student is marked 'present' in the class. Indicate attendance at sessions by leaving the appropriate spaces on the register blank and absence by entering an "A". If a learner is admitted after the course begins, a horizontal line is entered through all spaces up to the date on which the learner was admitted (see learners 9 and 10 in the sample). If a learner withdraws, a horizontal line is entered through the remaining spaces (see learners 2,3 and 5 on first register example-Adult Credit).
"C" day - Where an instructional session has been cancelled owing to exceptional circumstances (e.g., inclement weather has caused a breakdown in transportation arrangements or otherwise prevents learners from attending class), the session will be recognized for funding purposes if the instructor is still paid for the session and the session is not rescheduled. This session must be marked with a " C " in the register to indicate the cancellation, and the reason for the cancellation must be recorded.

## Average Daily Enrolment (ADE) Formula=

sum of total \# sessions attended by students x hours per session $\div 950$ (950 represents full time equivalent hours for a student Sept. to June $=190$ days x 5)

## Daily Attendance Formula Registers

Number of Sessions Recognized for Funding (Adult Credit, litnum, SumSch, Adult Native Language)

- If a learner has been absent for three or more consecutive sessions, the number of consecutive sessions missed is subtracted from the total number of sessions (see learners $3,4,5$, and 7 ).
- If a learner begins the course late, all sessions missed at the beginning are subtracted from the total (see learners 9 and 10).
- Note that a cancelled session (marked "C") does not add to the number of consecutive missed sessions (see learners 3 and 7) AND it does not interrupt consecutive absences (see learner 3).

Small Class Hours Adjustment is based on the average enrolment over the entire course. (Total Number of Learner Hours divided by the Total Number of Hours of Classroom Instruction). Refer to the Ministry of Education SB15 memorandum dated July 15,2005 for more information.


To determine the Small Class Hours Adjustment (column 6), the "small class adjustment possible" is multiplied by the Total Number of Hours of Classroom Instruction.

For example, for a course with an average enrolment of 10 and 100 Total Hours of Classroom Instruction, the small class hours adjustment is 500 additional hours of funding (see below for calculation).

100 total hours of classroom instruction x 5 (small class adjustment possible) $=500$ learner hours.
